 $\ensuremath{\operatorname{\textsc{Dogs}}}$ with no clinical signs of hypothyroidism and results within the reference interval are likely euthyroid. Occasionally, hypothyroid dogs can have a low normal T4 (1-2 $\mbox{ug}/\mbox{dL})$. Hypothyroidism may be further assessed in these dogs by adding a free T4 and canine TSH. For dogs on thyroid supplement, recommended therapeutic levels are 2.1-5.4 ug/dL. If this sample was drawn 4-6 hours post-pill in a dog on thyroid supplement, a low normal T4 $\,$ suggests inadequate supplementation.
